GRASS Submission Requirements

Congratulations on being selected for a California Grassland Research Awards for Student Scholarship (GRASS). We commend you for your research focused on understanding, preserving, and restoring California's native grassland ecosystems in accordance with the [CNGA Mission and Goals](#). Upon accepting your award, you agreed to these submission requirements:

- Recipients are required to submit at least one journal article to the CNGA publication *Grasslands* and/or present their work at the CNGA GRASS Award Speaker Series.
- The CNGA GRASS Grant Program should be acknowledged in theses, publications, or other products resulting from your research.

We do not expect students to complete their research in one year. Therefore, you may submit any of these items in lieu of an original research article:

- Research overview
- Visit a grassland
- Species spotlight
